PLEASE USE BLOCK LETTERS

NOTES: Only a Team Manager or a Team Coach, who is designated in advance of the Championships, may protest in writing, using the standard Protest Form, to the Referee providing that:-

- i) a verbal warning of the intention to protest is given within five (5) minutes of the incident, for example, the announcement of a disqualification by the Referee
- ii) the form is completed and handed to the Referee within ten (10) minutes of the incident to which it relates.
- iii) it is accompanied by a Protest Fee of **\$20.00** which will be returned if the protest is deemed not to have been frivolous.
- iv) the Referee will notify the Announcer to withhold that event result.
