

WORLD DROWNING PREVENTION DAY COMPETITIONS COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS



1. The competitions are open to children three to 14 years.
2. Competition opens on Monday 1st June 2026 and closes at 11.59pm AEST on Monday 13th July 2026. Late entries will not be considered for prizes.
3. Only one entry per person per competition will be accepted.
4. To enter you must be a resident of Australia.
5. The judging panel's decision is final. No discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
6. Royal Life Saving Society – Australia reserves the right to use all materials submitted in the announcement of winners.
7. Personal information captured will only be used to contact the parents/guardians of winners.

Judging

8. Entries will be judged by a panel of staff of Royal Life Saving Society – Australia and its State and Territory Member Organisations.
9. Judging will be based on merit of the entry using criteria to help make the process fair and consistent. Consideration for age and effort will be taken into account.

Adults Consent

10. Submitting an entry to the competition means that a parent or guardian has given consent based on these Terms and Conditions.
11. Submitting an entry to the competition means that these Terms and Conditions have been accepted.
12. Submitting an entry to the competition means the parent or guardian has given consent to publish that winning entry and the entrant's first name, age and State/Territory on Royal Life Saving Society – Australia's webpage and social media channels.

Prizes

13. The 20 winners will each receive a Zoggs Prize Pack valued at approximately \$140 – 10 winners for each competition.
14. The parents or guardians of the winners will be notified by email or phone during the week following 20th July 2026.
15. The prizes will be sent to the winners by Royal Life Saving Society – Australia by 31st July 2026.
16. The prizes cannot be exchanged, transferred, or be redeemed for cash or any other prizes.

Other Rules
