The Under 14 Presentation and Welcome Function will be held at Pymble Ladies College Aquatic and Fitness Centre on Friday 11 January at the conclusion of Day 1 events.

All teams, individuals, coaches / managers and officials will need to register and make payment online for their participation in the Australian Pool Life Saving Championships (APLSC) 2019 prior to the commencement of the Championships.

Any outstanding registrations fees owing on the first day of APLSC 2019 may result in refusal of entry. Additional persons (eg. spectators) will need to register for functions, and or if they require a program or merchandise item as part of the online registration process.

KEY OFFICIALS NOMINATIONS

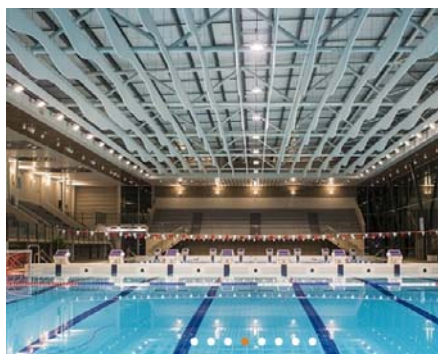
Key Officials Nominations are now open for the 2020-2021 Australian Pool Life Saving Championships.
