The Northern Territory Pool Lifesaving Team travelled to Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre to compete at the 2024 Australian Pool Lifesaving Championships from 18-20 January. The team made up of 10 athletes, 3 officials and 1 team manager included 3 athletes competing for the first time.

The elite competition sees lifesavers from across Australia compete in speed events in the pool - swimming races with a lifesaving twist - and events with a humanitarian purpose including CPR and the Simulated Emergency Response Competition (SERC).

This year Western Australia took home the overall title for the first time in 20 years. Team Manager and Coach Laura Withers said the competition was one of the best with Team NT taking home 4 medals, 1 overall age champion trophy and 16 personal bests. Some returning athletes shaved close to 20 seconds off previous times!

Congratulations to all the athletes, volunteers, managers, coaches and officials on another successful event celebrating the only sport with a humanitarian purpose.






























POOL LIFESAVING


















TRAINING
