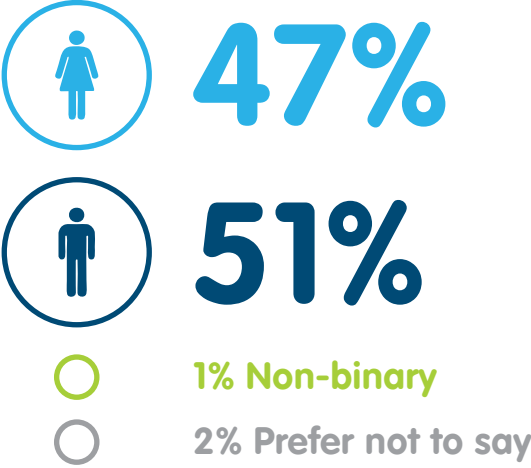

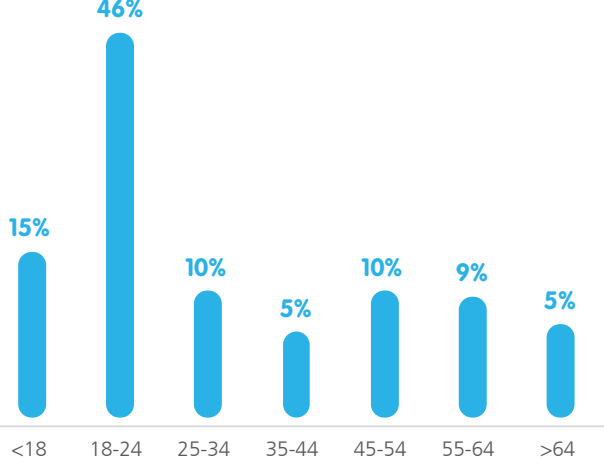


- is 24 or younger

- thinks they will stay in their role for up to five more years

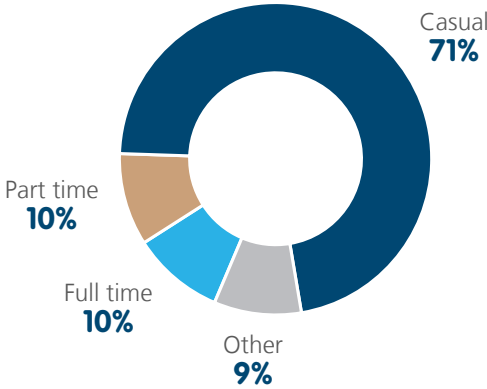

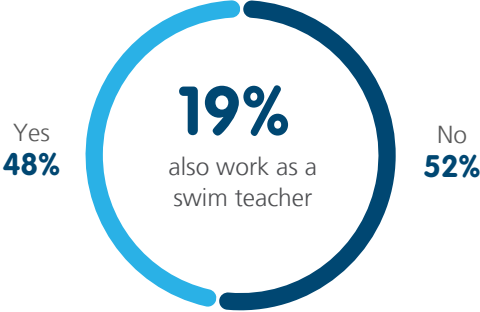

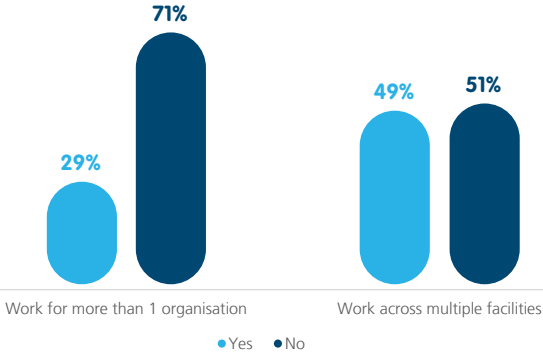
