CODE OF ETHICS

All Royal Life Saving Society Australia's Office Bearers, Administrative staff, Professional staff and Volunteers are required to abide by the following Code of Ethics

- Respect the rights of others, treating everyone equally and fairly and showing no discrimination in regards to sex, age, disability, religion or cultural background.
- Uphold the Objectives of the Society and abide by its Policies and Procedures.
- Ensure that all your activities associated with your role in the Society are exercised to the best of your ability and carried out with honesty and integrity.
- Conduct yourself in a professional manner ensuring your actions and behaviour do not compromise the Society's standing in the Community.
- Commit to a positive, open, supportive and honest cultural framework with which the Society operates, encouraging others to operate similarly.
- Compete within the spirit and rules of the Sport of Pool Lifesaving.
- Acknowledge and accept responsibility for your actions.
- Never make comparisons or statements about the Society, Members of the Society, and employees of the Society or the public that are not based on verifiable facts.
- Do not enter into any agreement or undertake any activity which may be in conflict with the Society's interest or which would prejudice the performance of its operations.
- At all times safeguard the Society's interest by not knowingly being party to or undertake any illegal, unprofessional and unethical activity.
- Do not use any confidential information gained from the Society for personal gain or in a manner which would be detrimental to or compromise the reputation or the activities of the Society.
