- Compete within the spirit and rules of the Sport of Pool Lifesaving.
- Acknowledge and accept responsibility for your actions.
- Never make comparisons or statements about the Society, Members of the Society, and employees of the Society or the public that are not based on verifiable facts.
- Do not enter into any agreement or undertake any activity which may be in conflict with the Society's interest or which would prejudice the performance of its operations.
- At all times safeguard the Society's interest by not knowingly being party to or undertake any illegal, unprofessional and unethical activity.
- Do not use any confidential information gained from the Society for personal gain or in a manner which would be detrimental to or compromise the reputation or the activities of the Society.
