


The Territory Check In App is available to download NOW!

It is a secure and contactless way for people to sign in to participating businesses and venues. You can even sign in for your family and friends.


Information collected using The Territory Check In app goes directly to NT Health and is safely and securely stored for 28 days to assist with contact tracing if required.
