Vision: To build a healthy, strong and safe aquatic community through access to water safety education and training.



## NATIONAL DROWNING REPORT 2020/21








Sadly 5 Territorians lost their lives to drowning during 2020/21.





That's your: voxygen resuscitation vspinals and vscenarios Re-qualified for another year. Keep up the great work you are doing by making our aquatic facilities safe.
















Pool Lifeguard training week continued with another update at Parap Pool October 7. A big thank you to YMCA legend Louise for sharing her knowledge.


What a fantastic afternoon spent in Batchelor on October 21.


